Enforced times, rates and locations
(Effective July 6, 2015)

P_v Community Centre Parkade
First two hours - no charge

7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday–Friday
Additional time – \$2 per hour
(Parking on Level P1 only during these times)

After 5 p.m. on weekdays, and all day weekends and holidays
Any additional time – \$2 flat fee
(Parking on Level P1 and P2)

Parkade hours of operation
Monday–Friday: 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.
Saturday: 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.
Sunday: 10:30 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Handicap parking
Available in the parkade on Level P1 and P2.
No charge to drive down to the elevators to drop off or pick up a person with disabilities.

No charge to drive down to P1 to use the library book return bin.

Street Parking - no charge

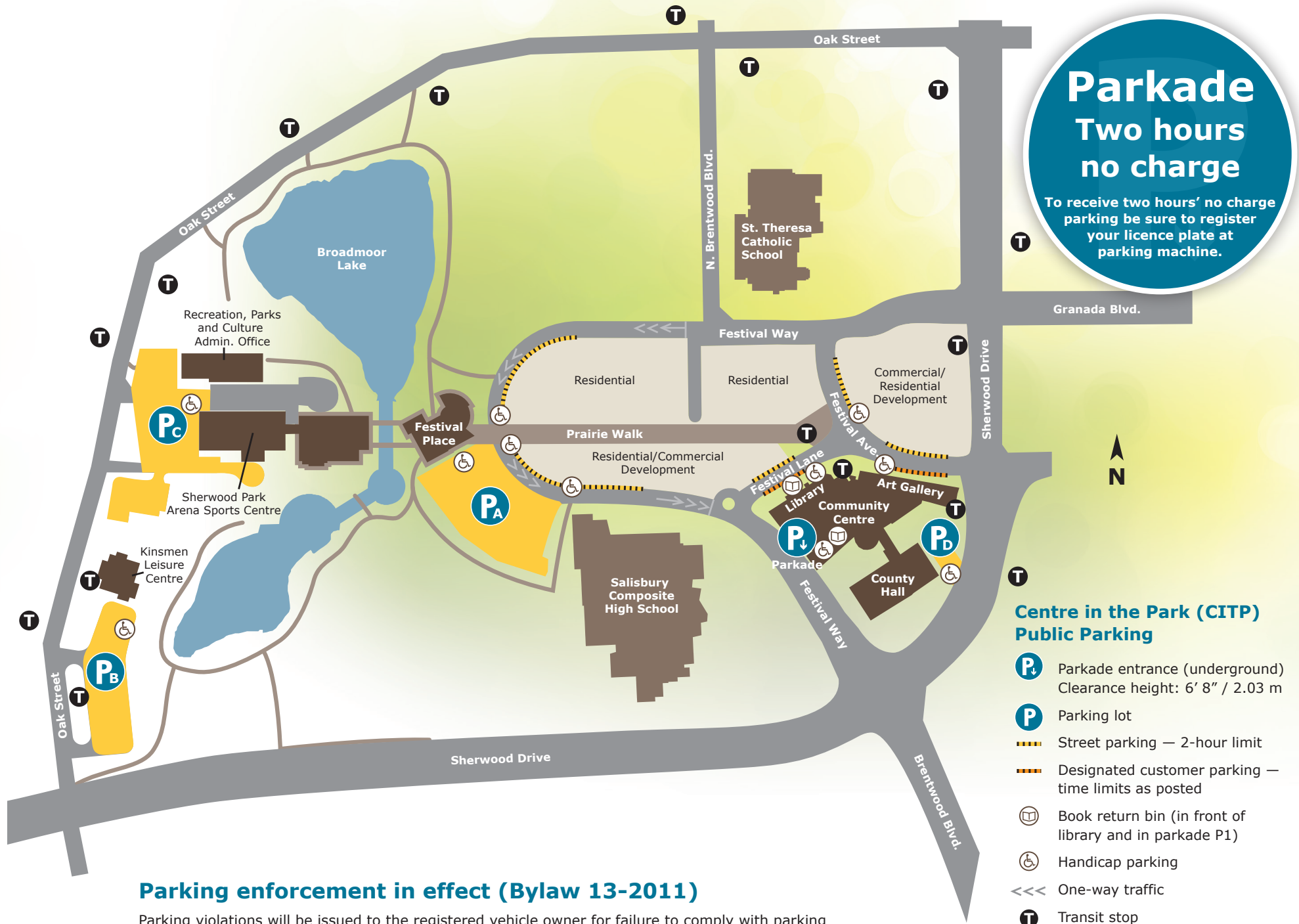
Festival Lane, Festival Avenue, Festival Way

- 2-hour time limit, or as posted
7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday–Friday
- No time limit after 5 p.m. on weekdays, and all day weekends and holidays

Outdoor Surface Parking Lots - no charge

- P_A Lot A – Festival Place**
- P_B Lot B – Kinsmen Leisure Centre**
- P_C Lot C – Sherwood Park Arena and Sports Centre**
- P_D Lot D – County Hall**
 - 2-hour time limit
7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday–Friday

Note: Parking rates and time limits are reviewed annually.

To receive two hours' no charge parking be sure to register your licence plate at parking machine.

Parking enforcement in effect (Bylaw 13-2011)

Parking violations will be issued to the registered vehicle owner for failure to comply with parking time limits and/or fees as posted. During construction or events, parking restrictions or changes may apply.
